AGREEMENT WITH PROGRAMMING POLICIES

Summary of the Programming Policies of Cambridge Community Television

1. I understand that CCTV does not cablecast programming that falls below minimal technical standards. See the Cablecast Agreement for information on formatting requirements.
2. I agree to obtain all necessary clearances and permissions from any and all individuals, businesses, organizations, or groups as may be needed to produce and/or cablecast programming for CCTV's channels. All programming cablecast on CCTV's channels will be webcast (simultaneously streamed) on CCTV's website.
3. I will be thoroughly familiar with the nature of the material of any program I submit for cablecast and take full responsibility for its content.

The following are prohibited on Channels 8, 9, and 96:

- Programming that does not have necessary clearances, releases, or other assurances from copyright holders and/or those appearing in the production.
- Programming that does not fall under constitutionally protected speech and raises serious risk of liability on the part of CCTV. This may include, but is not limited to: libel, slander; unlawful invasion of privacy; sedition (advocacy of violent overthrow of the government); or obscene material.

Obscene material as determined by the courts is material which:

- to the average person, applying contemporary community standards, taken as a whole, appeals to the prurient interest
- depicts or describes sexual content in a patently offensive way
- and taken as a whole, lacks serious literary, artistic, political, or scientific value.

The following are prohibited on Channels 8 and 9:

- Programming that contains advertising content. This may include: promotion of the sale or price of any product or service; commercial calls to action or inducements to buy.
- Programming that contains contact information in the form of addresses, phone numbers, and websites. Only names of individuals, businesses, organizations, or groups are permitted.

Non-English programming that contains advertising content is permitted on Channel 96.

Non-English programming that contains contact information in the form of addresses, phone numbers, and websites (in addition to names of individuals, businesses, organizations, or groups) is permitted on Channel 96.

I agree to use my best judgment and make CCTV aware (on the Cablecast Agreement) of any programming that contains potentially objectionable content. This may include, but is not limited to: strong, coarse language, intensely suggestive dialogue, or coarse indecent language; intense sexual situations or explicit sexual activity; most forms of nudity; intense or graphic physical violence or degradation; or graphic depiction of medical procedures. CCTV staff may also make their own judgment about whether a program contains potentially objectionable content.

CCTV has the right to cablecast programming that contains potentially objectionable content only between the hours of 11 PM and 5 AM and to place a disclaimer before and/or after the programming. The disclaimer will advise viewer discretion for the programming and will indicate that responsibility for the content of the programming lies with the program provider and not with CCTV, nor the City of Cambridge, nor the cable provider.

4. I understand that I am responsible for the production and presentation of my programs. I agree to hold harmless the cable provider, the City of Cambridge, CCTV, and CCTV's directors and employees (and their successors) from any liability, loss, claim, cost or damage of any nature whatsoever which may arise by reason of any claim that any material produced, cablecast or disseminated by me infringes or violates any rights of any individual or organization.
